Risk of War

- (1) Chen Shui-bian declared that his narrow reelection victory was a mandate from voters to press ahead with an aggressive agenda to develop Taiwan as an independent, sovereign country despite the risk of war with China. (Philip Pan and David Hoffman, Taiwan's President Maintains Hard Line, Washington Post, March 29)
- (2) Mr. James Kelly, Assistant Secretary of State, warned Chen Shui-bian on April 22 that unilateral moves toward independence could prompt a Chinese military response that could destroy much of what Taiwan has built and crush its hopes for the future. He warned that it will be irresponsible of USA and Taiwan to treat China's warning as empty threat.
- (3) Chen Shui-bian wants to push his personal agenda of "referendum to rewrite Constitution" (公投制憲) in 2006. This change of status quo will place the 23 million Taiwanese in grave danger.
